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Air Force Special Warfare Overview



Air Force Special Warfare (AFSPEWAR) forces integrate air, space, and cyber power with special operations and conventional forces to provide global access, precision strike and personnel recovery capabilities for the Joint Force.

AFSPEWAR is comprised of three components:

- Guardian Angel (GA) Weapons System
- Tactical Air Control Party (TACP) Weapon System
- Special Tactics (ST) Forces

The primary AFSPEWAR AFSCs are:

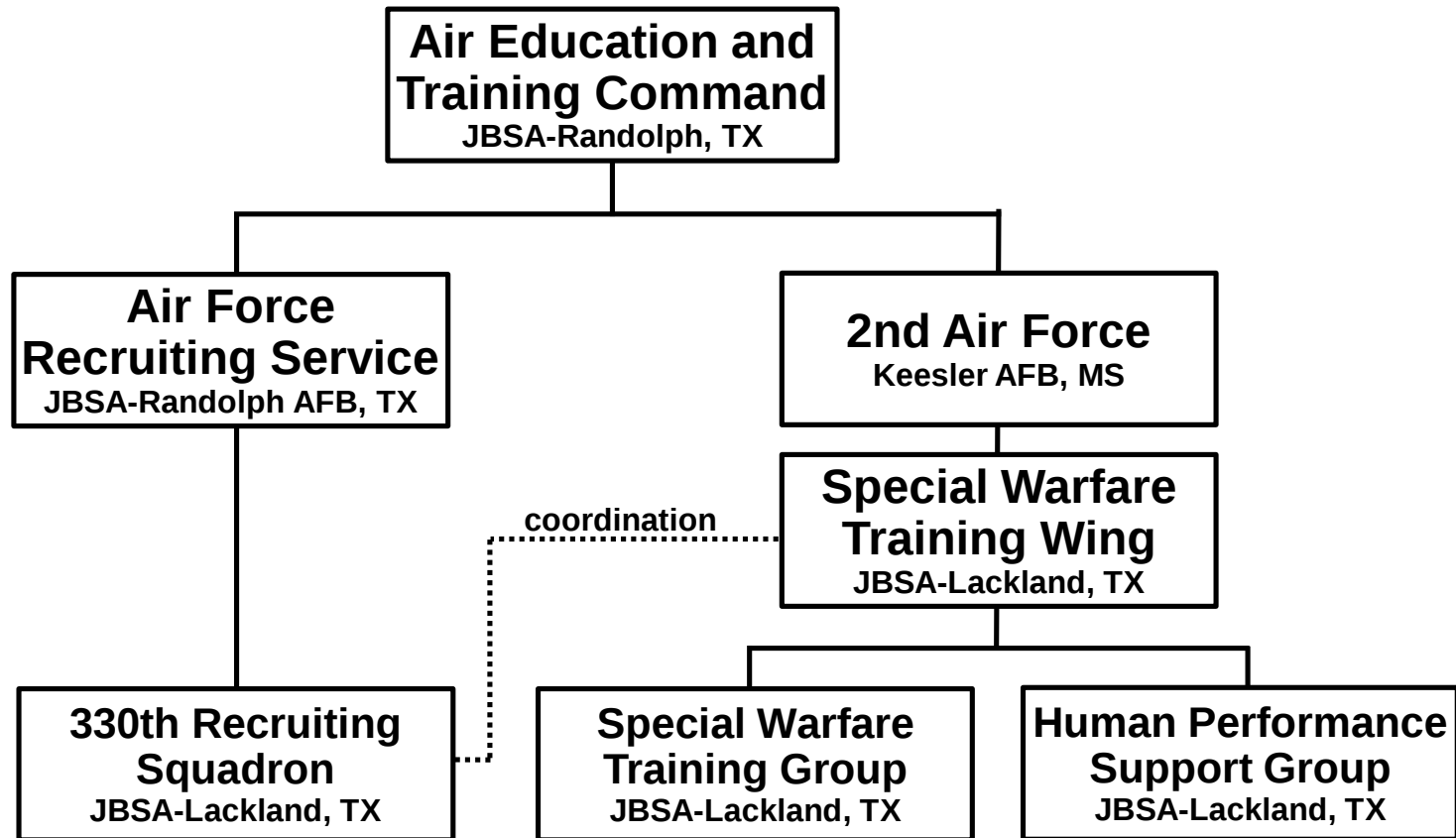
- Combat Control (CCT)

Mission: Recruit, train, and develop ground combat forces that specialize in airpower application



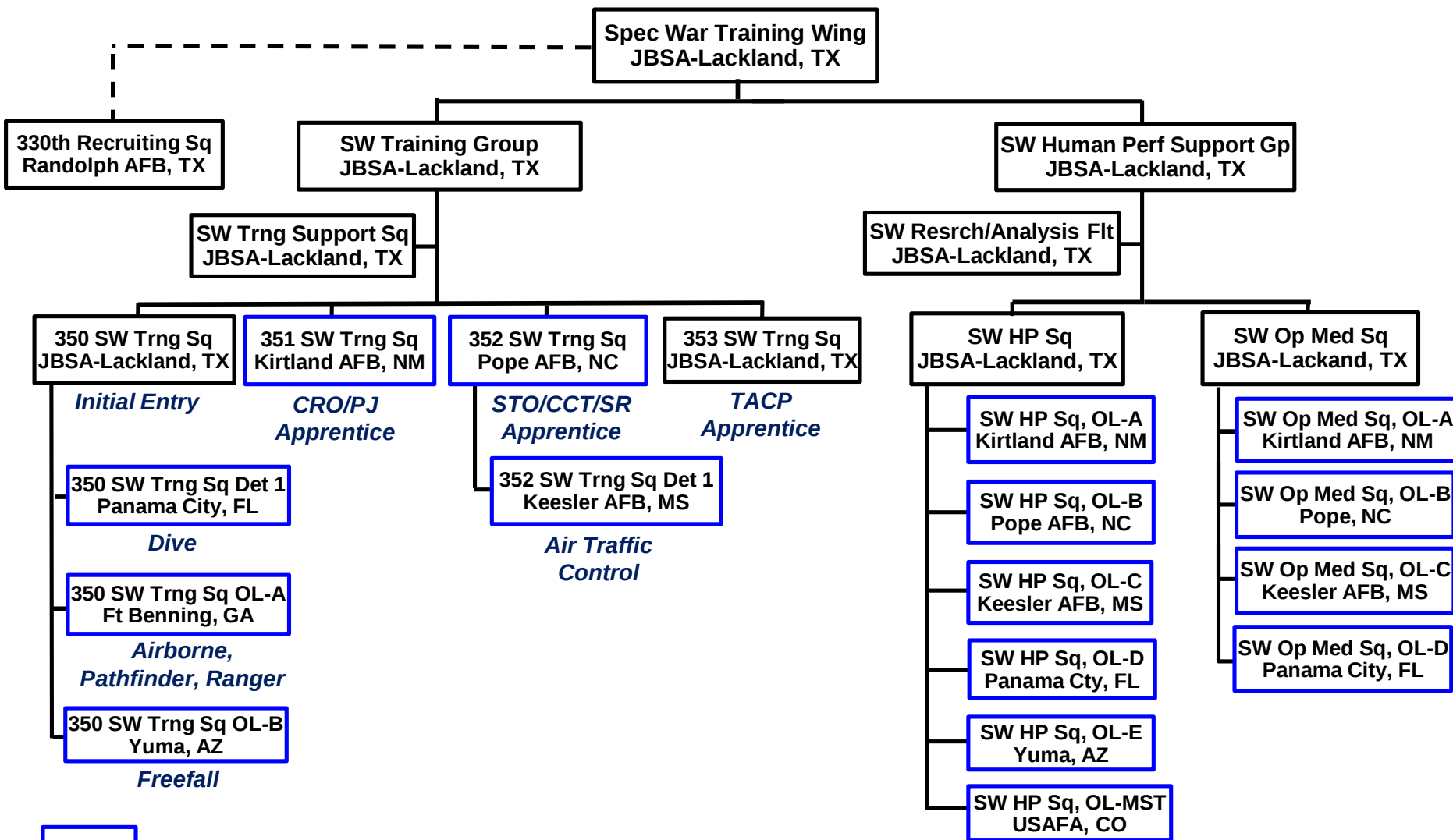
Building the human foundation of Air Force Special Warfare capability

= geographically separated unit

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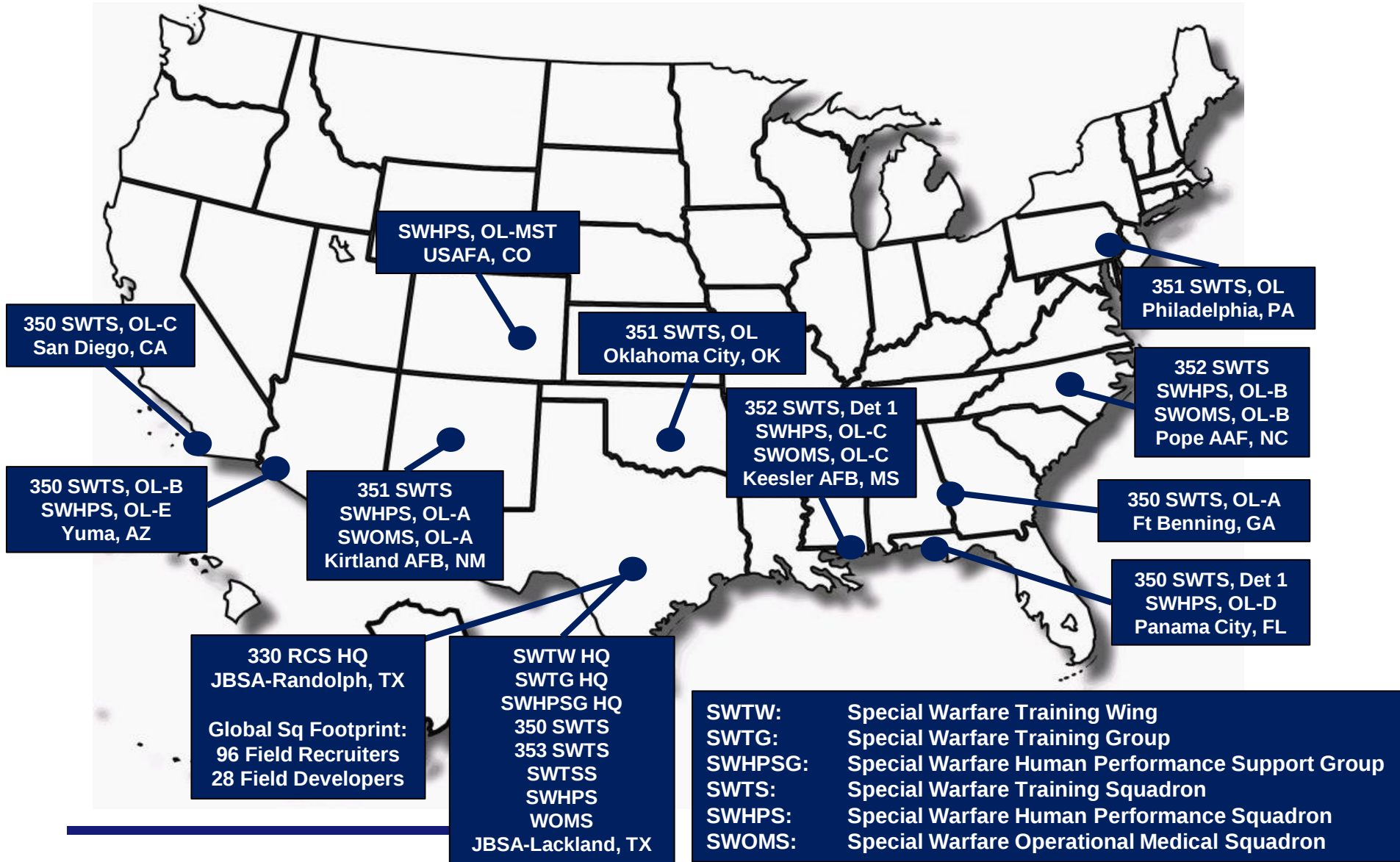


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Special Warfare Training Wing Footprint



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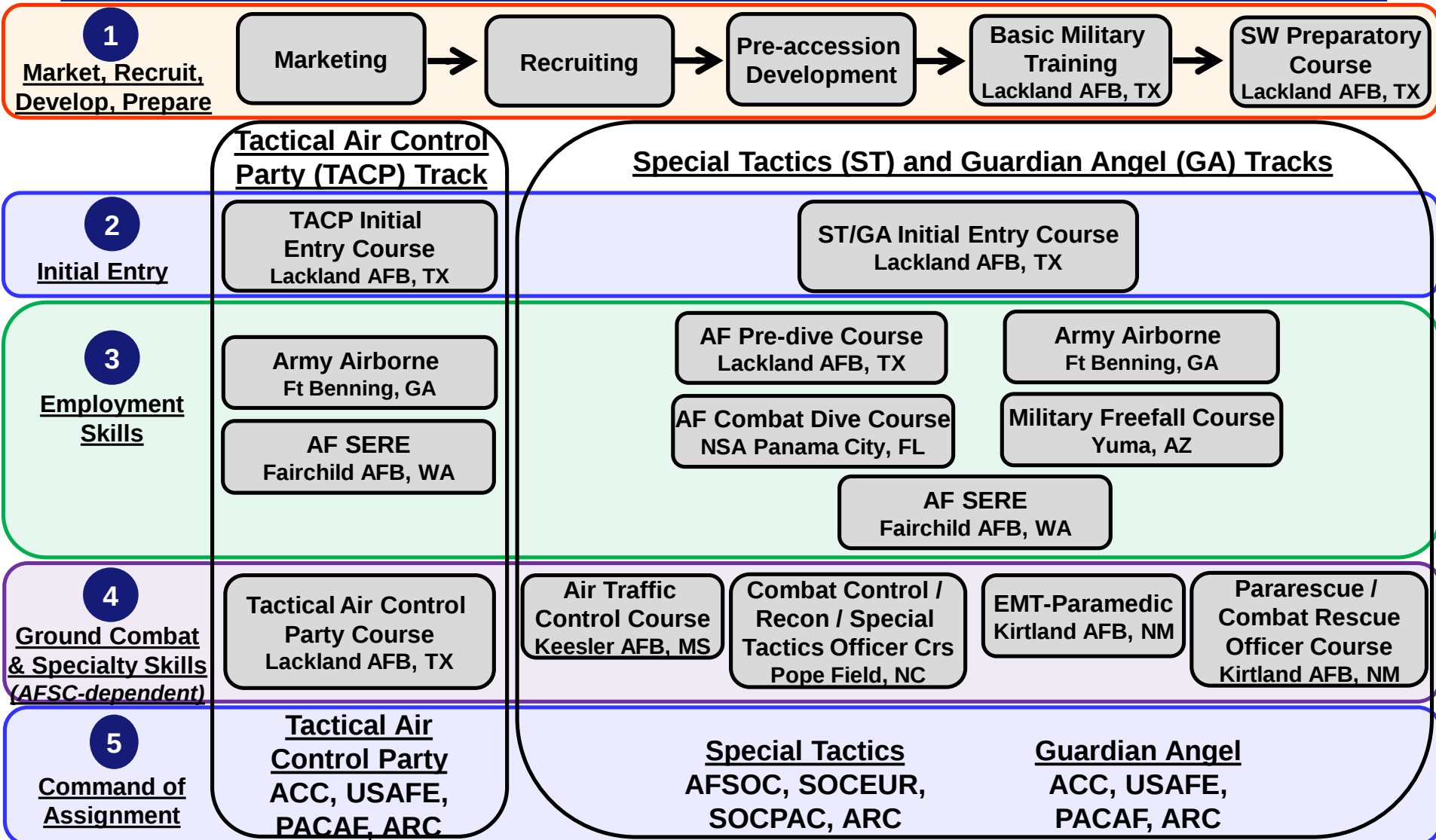


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Special Warfare Training Wing Pipeline Overview



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Special Warfare Training Wing Human Performance Overview

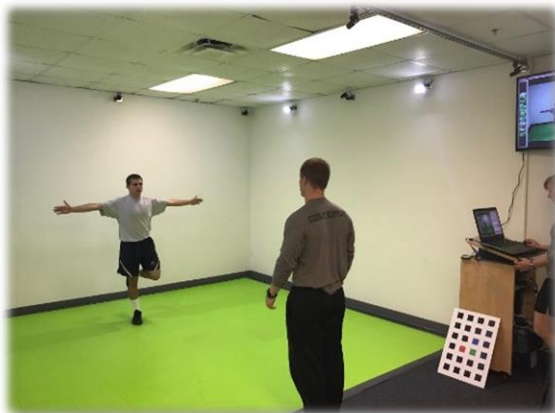
